What's a limerick?

- A limerick is form of funny verse, frequently rude.
- It consists of five lines with a strict rhyme scheme of AABBA.
- That is, the first, second, and fifth lines rhyme, while the third and fourth lines are shorter and share a different rhyme.

Here's an example:

PEA SOUPER

THERE WAS A YOUNG WOMAN RIGHT THERE!
A MINUTE AGO - SAT ON THAT CHAIR!
DOES IT SEEM RISIBLE
SHE'S GONE INVISIBLE?
JUST VANISHED LIKE SMOKE IN THIN AIR...
